ASSEMBLY

Teachers will continue to present their 'Striving For Excellence' Awards and Student Leaders will also make their presentations of their respective awards. Our assemblies are student lead and commence with an Acknowledgment to Country and our National Anthem. At our first assembly for the year, we will be presenting badges to our school leaders for 2021.

TUTOR LEARNING INITIATIVE

The Department have introduced the Tutor Learning Initiative this year. The Tutor Learning Initiative is designed to support students whose learning has been disrupted as a result of the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. Schools must only use their funding to engage tutors to provide targeted teaching to students identified as needing support. Tutors are to be qualified teachers. This commences in Term 1. Schools are able to determine the most appropriate model of tutoring for their school and students, with support from regional staff and guided by the evidence, resources and professional learning developed by the Department. We will be proving this support to students in the form of small group work. Current research suggests that small-group learning offered through focused, regular sessions with a trained teacher is a clear evidence-based approach for improving student-learning outcomes in a timely manner (Grattan Institute, 2020).

Our school has used our data sets to identify students who we feel will benefit from participation in this initiate. The sessions will take the place 3 times per week. These will take the form on small group work both in and outside the classroom. Tutors will work closely with classroom teachers with the aim of supporting students with their learning. Currently we are working on timetabling. We are very fortunate to have Mrs Sibio, Mrs Serra, Mrs Sproule and Mrs Lipshut as our Tutors. Over the next three weeks, parents of the students who are participating in this initiate will be contacted and a meeting arranged to discuss your child's Education Plan. As this is a new initiative, we will be monitoring the progress closely and making adaptions as required.

DEPARTMENT GUIDELINES

The Department have developed new guidelines around parent entry to schools.

We are certainly all glad to know that we can welcome parents to school again!

There are still some extra regulations that we must all adhere to, to keep us all safe.

- Students can arrive at school from 8:40am each day (Note that the music commences at 8.55am all students are expected to be at school by this time)
- Students can be dropped off at any entrance
- At the end of the day, parents/carers can arrange to meet their child in the grounds, at the gates or at their car. Please confirm with your child, where you will be picking them up at 3:15 pm.
- At this stage we will not commence having parents in for reading.

Parents/carers can come into the school grounds- with restrictions

- Face masks must be carried at all times.
- Face masks are recommended when
 1.5 metres physical distancing cannot be maintained.
- There are limits on the number of visitors that can be in the corridors and rooms at any time, so visits to classrooms and the buildings must be pre-arranged.
- Parents who choose to drop their children off within the school grounds are asked to do so outside the buildings.
- Foundation/Grade 1 teachers will meet their classes outside, along the

verandah area, each morning at 8:55am.

- Foundation/Grade 1 students are to be picked up from the verandah area/ or school crossing at 3:15pm.
- If there is a chance that a parent or visitor will remain within the school grounds for longer than 15 minutes, they must check-in via the Service Victoria app. The scannable QR code will be found at the entrances to the office. If you can't scan you must register manually at the office via the main entrance.
- We are maintaining an enhanced cleaning schedule at school, with all high touch areas and the toilets being cleaned twice a day – thanks Grant!
- Drink bottles are still strongly encouraged, but there are two bubble taps available on the side of each building, as well as taps to fill drink bottles.
- Where possible, continue to communicate via email or by phone.
- Remember that we need to stay home if unwell- students and staff- and get tested if we have any COVID symptoms.
