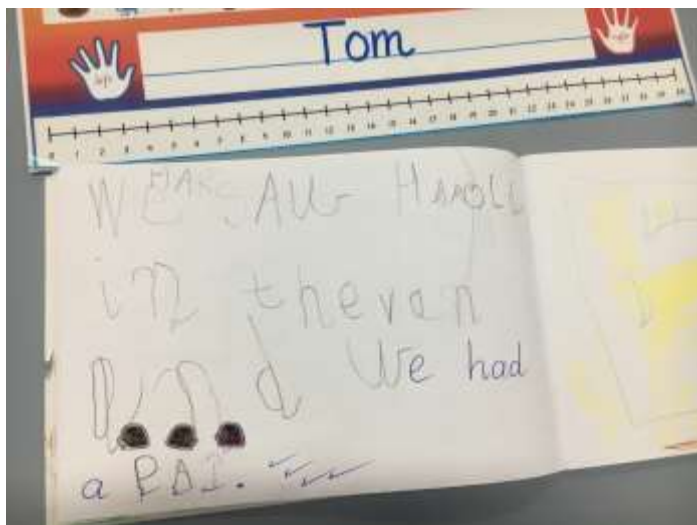
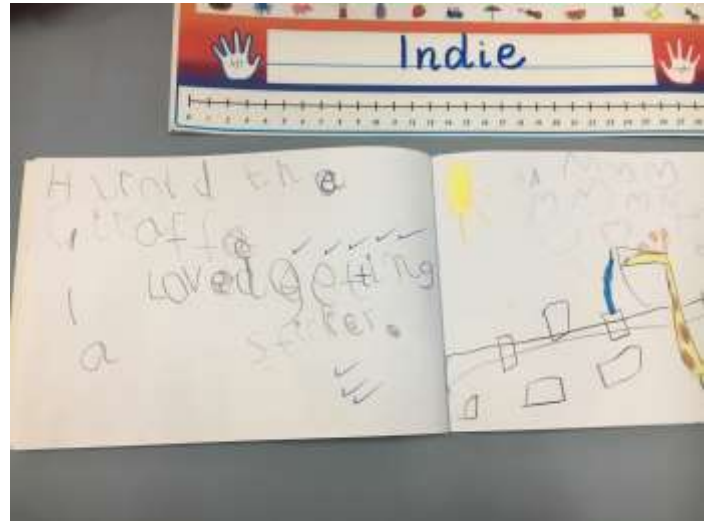


PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

SOCIAL SKILLS PROGRAM
