TOOLAMBA STEERING COMMITTEE UPDATE

The Toolamba and District Community Plan Steering Committee's role is to prioritise and facilitate large and small projects in and around Toolamba for the benefit of the whole community. The committee meets monthly to discuss progress on projects already within our Toolamba & District Community Plan, as well as put forward new ideas for consideration and is supported by Shepparton Council, through a community liaison officer, as well as other major stakeholders.

The committee ensures Toolamba residents and other service groups are invited to participate and offer their opinions when new projects are being considered. Our current community action plan was put together in 2016 after engagement across the Toolamba community that included a sausage sizzle, an online survey and questionnaires. You may have seen recent communications from us in conjunction with Council that have included asking you to vote on the proposed design for our community playground in Colaura Gardens as well as having your say as part of the pre-draft consultation for the Toolamba Townships Growth Plan.

Some of our recent projects include:

- Successfully advocating for funding of the Toolamba Bridge repairs,
- Securing funding for a Youth SPOT, in collaboration with the Recreation Reserve Committee, to be installed close to the Community Hall,
- Installation of a new Goulburn Valley Water refill station within Colaura Gardens,
- Installation of the new School Crossing.

Other activities that are currently being progressed include the installation of a new community town sign,

feasibility studies for walking and biking tracks, design and installation of fitness stations around the community oval and improvements to the curb/channel/guttering. We will keep you informed on how these are progressing. The Toolamba Community Plan with all its current projects can be found on Council's website for anyone who wishes to read it in full.
