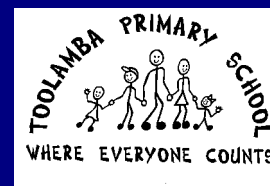

Reading

Please ensure that you are continuing to listen to your child read. It is important that the take home books are practiced **all week, every night** and only changed on whole school book change day (Friday), or when a

reading conference has been completed by a teacher. This allows students to become familiar with the text. They also have an opportunity to practice their Reading Goal or class focus on the same book they have used during Independent Reading at school. By having the same set of books for a whole week students can learn to be fluent readers and read like they are telling a story to a friend.

Writing

We are loving our Information Report writing! The students are very engaged and excited to be able to write down true facts and know if they are connected to an animals diet, appearance or habitat. I hope you have enjoyed seeing some of these come home. I am very proud of all the efforts the students have put into this writing and hope that it continues into our Narrative writing in the coming weeks.

While Foundation are at Buddies, Grade One have started working together to create a huge information report book all about animals. We are so excited to share this at assembly (when we have finished) and for it to be available for all to read in the learning street. Keep your eyes open for our gigantic big book.

Maths

Please don't hesitate ask your child about their learning of Doubles particularly to 10... 'Double 3 makes...'. We have also done a lot of work on Friends of 10... '8 and ? makes 10'. We have practiced addition concepts in many ways using concrete materials as well as written form. Our focus is to make these facts fluent and known. This will assist future learning and bigger numbers. We are also beginning to introduce Subtraction.
