SPOONVILLE

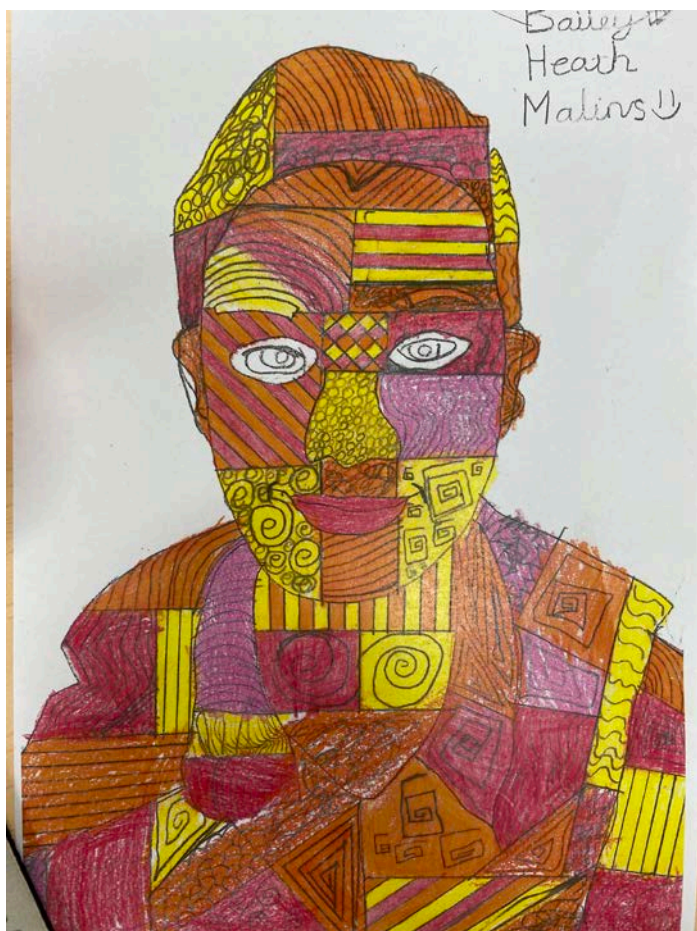
Students were eagerly looking forward to their art lesson on Wednesday when they had the opportunity to create characters to join the Spoonville Community.
